Background

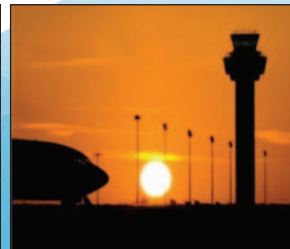
